<b>~</b>   <u></u> Ω:	(Transfer)	Transfers the current call and Right/Forward when entering dial pad characters.
	(Message)	Connects to voice mailbox and notifies when you have messages and have been queued internally to return a call. Toggles between Alpha Mode and Numberic Mode when entering dial pad characters.

# HANDLING CALLS

1. Receiving Calls	Pick up the handset or press the Ringing Line key or the Speaker button (automatically places you on speaker phone).	
2. Making Outside Calls	Either lift the handset (or leave it down to be on speaker phone), and press Call Key 1, Call Key 2, Call Key 3, or Outgoing or Speaker button.	
3. Intercom Calls	Dial extension number, phone rings. If no answer, call goes to Voice Mail in 15 seconds.	
4. Transferring Calls	Transfer Direct to Extension	While connected to the caller, press Transfer button, enter extension and hang up.
	Supervised Transfer	While connected to caller, press Transfer button, enter extension, wait for party to answer, announce caller, hang up. If called party doesn't want call, press the Line/Call Key button to pull it back, press Voice Mail, enter Extension then hang up
	Transfer Direct to Voice Mail	While connected to the caller, press Voice Mail button, enter extension and then hang up. The caller is transferred directly into the person's Voice Mailbox.
	Reverse Transfer (Call Pickup)	You can pick up a call holding or ringing at another phone or another office by pressing "4", then the extension number where the call is ringing or holding. This will pull the call to your extension.
5. Hold	Placing a Call on Hold	While on the call, press the Hold key, the caller hears music on hold. To pick back up, press Hold again or the flashing call button.
	Picking up a Call from Hold on another Extension	To pick up a call that is on <u>hold</u> at another phone/extension by pressing the digit "4", then the extension number where the call is holding. This will transfer the call to your extension.
6. Mute	At any time you may mute a handset/speaker call by pressing the Mute key. The light next to the button will lite indicating the call is muted and the display will indicate it as well. To shut it off press the Mute key again, the light will shut off.	
7. Redial	Press Redial, to dial the last outside telephone number which you called.

# **CONFERENCE CALLS**

### You can have a total of 8 parties on a conference call.

- 1) While connected to a call, Press the CONFERENCE button.
- 2) Make your next call (internal extension, or an outside party\*)

## \*If you're calling an outside caller you must Press a LINE button or the digit 8, then dial the phone number.

- 3) With the second call on the line.
- 4) Press CONFERENCE button twice to connect all parties.

Repeat steps 1-4, to add additional parties.

## **CUSTOMIZE YOUR PHONE**

#### LEAVE HANDSET IN CRADLE TO ACCESS FEATURE CODES

1. Select Ring Tone	Press <b>X</b> button then <b>398.</b> Press keys 1-9 to hear various tones and press <b>#</b> to accept the desired tone.
2. Adjust Volume of Ringer, Speaker, or Earpiece	While in desired mode adjust volume up or down with volume bar and press the center of the bar to save the volume level.
3. To Set the Language, Text Size, Brightness & Contrast and Screen Saver	Press the Applications button Press the Setting button -Select Languages to change language -Select Text Size to change to large or small text -Select Brightness & Contrast to adjust -Select Screen Saver to set time & brightness Once you have made your change Press Save button
